1 Your Honor:

2 In response to your answer, I am filing an appeal as our case was never read or heard.

3 This has been a travesty of justice.

4 Our case basically states that we had an illegal home invasion, and a robbery of our home
5 by an ex-cop, who was fired from the San Jose Police Department for falsifying records,
6 robbery, home invasion and impersonating a federal and a state official. He is Mike
7 Frasier, an ex-con artist and a criminal with a long record of felonies, crimes and illegal
8 activities. He is the person the Humane Society hired and he has been committing these
9 crimes for 10 years now. The FBI has full knowledge of Mike Frasier's past. They are
10 waiting to catch him in the commission of one of his felony crimes.

11 We have witnesses to substantiate our home invasion. Mike Frasier entered our property
12 illegally by trespassing for two months prior to the illegal break-in and robbery. Mike
13 Frasier doe not work for the District Attorney's office and never did, yet he used the
14 District Attorney's stationery for his phony search warrants and signed his name Mike
15 Frasier, (a private citizen) as the affiant. Then he flashed a phony search warrant he had
16 made up in order to gain entry. There are 13 other plaintiffs he has used the same
17 stationery on. Mike Frasier is a private person from a non-profit organization and a
18 private citizen DOES NOT have police powers at all. Mike Frasier still thinks he is a cop.
19 Additionally, you can't get a search warrant for cats. I had rescued some from a burned
20 down pet store in Los Gatos where I live. He used the cats as an excuse to gain entry
21 onto our property and into our home. He then robbed us of \$3000.00 in cash, jewelry, a
22 gun and other items. He totally destroyed the inside of our home for 3 1/2 hours. (Does it
23 take 3 1/2 hours to count a few cats?) After damaging our home, he photographed the
24 damage and put it on television with no signed permission from us. We were not charged

1 with any crime or anything at all. Mike Frasier just wanted to be a big shot and have his
2 picture in the paper.

4 This man has been doing this type of illegal activity for over 10 years now and never got
5 caught until he did this to us. The Humane Society fired him for his actions. Now the local
6 authorities and the FBI know about him and his criminal past.

7 This is an an egregious, unconditionable, and despicable act to do to anyone, let alone two
8 innocent senior citizens. This act was perpetrated by a private citizen who thinks he has
9 police powers and who thinks he is still a cop. He is an ex-cop and a criminal. He has been
10 allowed by our system, to get away with these immoral, illegal acts for a long time.

12 A 12b-6 "failure to state a claim" has been used as a copout by the corrupt courts and our
13 judicial system and we want to appeal this decision. Its a case of **multiple crimes, not**
14 **cats!**

16 Because of our financial states, we went pro per and we have been stepped on and walked
17 all over by the judges and courts. I worked for the criminal justice system for 13 years at
18 the Boccardo Law Firm in San Jose and I have NEVER seen such blatant corruption in my
19 entire life. I fully intend to make this egregious act a public issue if we don't get any
20 satisfaction. This act was immoral, illegal and unconstitutional. We were denied case
21 management, discovery and a trial, all of which we asked for and were entitled to under the
22 constitution and which we never got.

24 Our case, again, was never a case of animals but rather a case of multiple felony crimes.

25 The cat issue was used to cover up and distract the real crimes. This is totally an
26 unconscionable act to do to two lifetime residents of this community by an ex-felon, ex-
27 cop, ex-con artist and a loose canon, Mike Frasier. He is free and we are the victims of his


1 crimes and prisoners in our own home. Because of the vast corruption in our courts, he
2 has been able to get away with these crimes for 10 years.

3 What is wrong with our system that the criminals run free and the innocent victims pay
4 such a high price for this abuse of the system. Where is justice, law and order? Where are
5 our constitutional and our civil rights and most of all, where is our morality? Is our society
6 so out of control with control, that the criminals run it and the innocent people suffer for
7 it? Is the corruption in our courts and our system so atrocious that this type of act can
8 happen to two innocent people and is allowed to be forgotten. I certainly hope not.

9 Please, I beg the court to review, read and let us appeal the decision rendered. I feel
10 confident that once you have reviewed the file and the facts you will agree that our request
11 for appeal is justified.
